Commission: Designed and welded a 30" x 30" x 78" fabricated bronze sculpture called *Scend* for the entrance to Gaiser Hall. This was to commemorate the College's 75th Anniversary. The base of the sculpture is used as a *time capsule*. Project was completed in 3 months.

Goddess Consort donated to Clark College Foundation by a private donor. Permanently sited outside Archer Gallery. The sculpture was originally designed and cast in 1996 at my studio. Responsible for preparing the sculpture for permanent siting. Welded a stainless steel base and collar attachment.
